

**Are the gates of the European Institutional Construction Site closed for citizens?  
A first comment to the last proposals of the Executive Board of the  
Conference on the future of Europe**

At the beginning the innovative idea was to create a public space to host a Conference on the future of Europe (CoFoE) open to civil society and institutions on equal foot.

After the solemn and first inauguration in Strasbourg the 9<sup>th</sup> of May with silent citizens on a large screen, it will be a second inauguration all over again in Strasbourg the 19<sup>th</sup> of June with the representatives of the national and European institutions.

It will be composed by nine working groups chaired by the nine official members of the Executive board.

How many citizens will be there, where they will seat and are they allowed to take the floor?

In fact, 28 “lucky” citizens – as winners of a European lottery as a substitute of the participatory democracy – will be invited in Lisbon two days before the plenary session having the chance to meet the three co-chairs of the Executive board, the other members of it being remotely.

Three of the lucky citizens will be allowed to speak and “*present their vision for the organization of CoFoE events at national level*”.

Two first citizens’ panels with 200 people each one - selected random- will be held in September in Florence (EUI), Maastricht, Dublin and Natolin (European College).

A second session of the 4 citizens’ panels will take place in November, in remote way only, with 200 people each one.

A third session of the 4 citizens’ panels will take place in December followed by a plenary session to discuss the conclusions of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> panels.

In January 2022, another plenary session will discuss the conclusions of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> citizens’ panels.

There will be two other plenary sessions in February and March to come up with proposals based on those citizens’ panels discussions.
