

## **Information Note for the attention of the Executive Board of the Conference on the Future of Europe**

### **Multilingual Digital Platform – Planning for the first interim report**

The Multilingual Digital Platform is the **main hub for citizens' contributions** to the Conference. In line with the Rules of Procedure of the Conference, the input gathered from the platform will be taken on board by the **European Citizens' Panels**. It will also be discussed, together with the recommendations of the Citizens' Panels, by the **Conference Plenary**.

**A service provider (Kantar)** working under a contract with the Commission's DG Communication has been commissioned to prepare **reports** on the platform, which will be published in 24 languages. The analysis is supported by a text-mining artificial intelligence tool run by the Commission's Joint Research Centre. As the reports are **deliverables by the service provider**, they do not need endorsement by the Co-Chairs or the Executive Board.

The **first interim report** should be ready ahead of the European Citizens' Panels taking up their work **in September**.

Based on the current available planning, the report will take account of data on the platform up to 2 August and will be **available on 10 September in all 24 languages**. It will be published on the platform and distributed to the European Citizens' Panels.

We also attach for your information a suggested **indicative planning on future reports** from the platform. The timing aims at providing information in a timely manner ahead of European citizens' panels and plenary sessions.
